- Maintain good knowledge of available components and understand their function.
- Work within the parameters of accepted "best practice" at all times. To ensure that all aspects of practice conform to clinical governance at all times.
- Act as a resource for clinical cover for annual leave, sickness, planned absences or emergency cover where appropriate.
- Work as part of a multi-disciplinary team to ensure the most appropriate and effective treatment for patients.
